

Press release / Kick-off meeting

The kick-off meeting for the project „Postcare 2.0: Informing the Care Services Workers on Posting Rules“ **was held on October 21, 2021**. All of the project partners participated in the online meeting. Prof. Grażyna Spytek-Bandurska, the representative of the Federation of Polish Entrepreneurs (project beneficiary), opened the meeting, after which the participants held brief presentations of the organizations and their institutions.

The project consortium is comprised of organizations from 5 EU member countries (Poland, Spain, Greece, the Netherlands, Lithuania) and 1 candidate country (Serbia), which gathered partners from countries of origin and host countries. Dr Marek Benio, the Vice-President of the European Labor Mobility Institute (ELMI), presented the project, its milestones, deadlines, surveys, and future events.

It was highlighted that the Postcare 2.0 project represents a continuation of the previous project funded by the EU, „POSTCARE 1.0“, focused on creating a database. The project will rely on research results with the aim of informing workers (third-country nationals employed in one EU country who are being posted to work in another EU country) and employers who are posting workers from third countries, with reference to the working conditions which these workers will encounter there.

During the discussion stage, and the Q&A stage, the expert shared the information regarding upcoming activities within the project, including the International online working meeting and the setting-up of Online information centers. Discussions centered around the implementation of these activities and presenting information to employees and employers using this Online information platform.
