

Press release / Online meeting

On March 31, 2023, an online meeting was held as part of the project „Postcare 2.0: Informing the Care Services Workers on Posting Rules“. The primary aim of these international online meetings was to draw up documents related to rules of employment, objectives, and the code of conduct for Information centers, for the purpose of sharing information related to the implementation of legislation in the EU, the impact of these centers on work, strengthening capacities of trade unions and employers, and providing relevant information to third-country nationals.

The meeting was divided into two segments, the first of which focused on internal topics, whereas the second was related to the online informative seminar. During the first segment of the meeting, each of the participants briefly shared their impressions and obstacles encountered with regard to the functioning of Online information centers. Matters which were discussed included practical issues, best practices, and communication channels.

In the second segment of the meeting, a panel discussion moderated by Dr Marek Benio, was organized and featured two guest speakers with experience in the field of care services, Ms. Iwona Przybyło and Ms. Bożena Adamczyk. Both guest speakers shared their practical experiences and discussed topics such as the quality of care services, efficient training, and challenges in employment, as well as employee fluctuation.

The discussion was interactive, and allowed the participants to ask questions, and was transmitted to a wider audience thanks to the participation of other guests who attended the conference online. Obligations related to the work of Online information centers in various countries were reaffirmed, and recommendations and possible solutions were presented. In addition to the above, the participants were invited to take part in the European Labor Mobility Congress 2023, where a panel discussion has been planned, and is to include topics encompassed by the POSTCARE 2.0 project.
