

## Press release / Second online meeting

**On October, 30, 2023, the second online meeting was held** and served to exchange information which had previously been gathered. Participants included the Independent professional trade union CSIT from Spain, Federation of Polish Entrepreneurs, European Labor Mobility Institute ELMI from Poland, International Road Federation (IRF) from the Netherlands, Aristotle University of Thessaloniki (Greece), InnovED (Center for Education and Innovation) from Greece, Trade Union of Employees in Health and Social Security of Serbia (SZZSZS), and „Solidaridad“ from Lithuania.

The representative of the organization – project beneficiary (Federation of Polish Entrepreneurs) presented the agenda for the meeting, and highlighted the progress that had been made on the project.

The discussion centered around topics related to POSTCARE Information labs on the national level, with a session in which the participants exchanged previous experiences, clarified doubts, and discussed the possibility of organizing Info Labs in a direct, hybrid or virtual form.

Group work sessions were included in the meeting, ideas presented, and discussions held regarding the overcoming of challenges related to posted workers in the care services sector. The meeting served as a central milestone for gathering information on how to proceed further, on the activities to be carried out, and the deadlines to be observed. There were also discussions about the preparation of national reports, recommendations and solutions, as well as about creating video materials, and drawing up three informative brochures and a general report on the work of OICs in all partner countries.
