The general aim of the **POSTCARE 2.0** project is to provide a significant contribution to the implementation of the fundamental principles of the European Pillar of Social Rights in the context of posting workers to EU member states. The above has been achieved through the development and advancement of various forms and formats of informing and consultations, as well as through the provision of consultations for third-country nationals related to posting standards and their inherent right to dignified working conditions. This aim has been attained through several key results achieved within the **POSTCARE 2.0** project, among others - the setting up of information centers, introductory orientation sessions, working meetings on an international level, creating „Information laboratories“, regular exchange of information, implementation of the online informative platform, as well as through the organization of a panel entitled „**POSTCARE 2.0**“ during the European Labor Mobility Congress 2023.

The **POSTCARE 2.0** project deals in a comprehensive manner with the representation of workers' countries of origin (Poland, Serbia, Lithuania), as well as host countries (Spain, Greece, the Netherlands). The project is focused on companies, employers, and employees in the health and care services sectors of these six countries, recognizing the critical importance of guaranteeing fair and adequate working conditions in a field as important as the field of care and care services for persons in need of care. By encompassing these countries, **POSTCARE 2.0** has positioned itself as a transnational initiative which strives to efficiently respond to the challenges and opportunities linked with labor mobility in the healthcare sector of the European Union.



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
